Visiting Guidelines

Texas Health is committed to keeping patients, visitors, and care team members safe. Our visitation guidelines aim to protect our patients and staff, while providing a safe environment for all. Normal visiting hours are from 6:30 a.m. - 8 p.m. (the front doors of the hospital open at 5 a.m.)

Visitors must:

- Keep a safe distance from others
- Follow all hospital staff instruction
- Practice good handwashing

Inpatient Services: Patients staying on our inpatient unit may have two visitors at a time within normal visitation hours who meet COVID-19 screening criteria.

Outpatient Services: Up to two support persons may be allowed, based on entity volume and capacity. No restrictions on visiting hours.

Please be considerate and keep your visit brief if the patient is in pain or in need of rest. One visitor is allowed to spend the night. Each private room is equipped with a small daybed that folds out.


